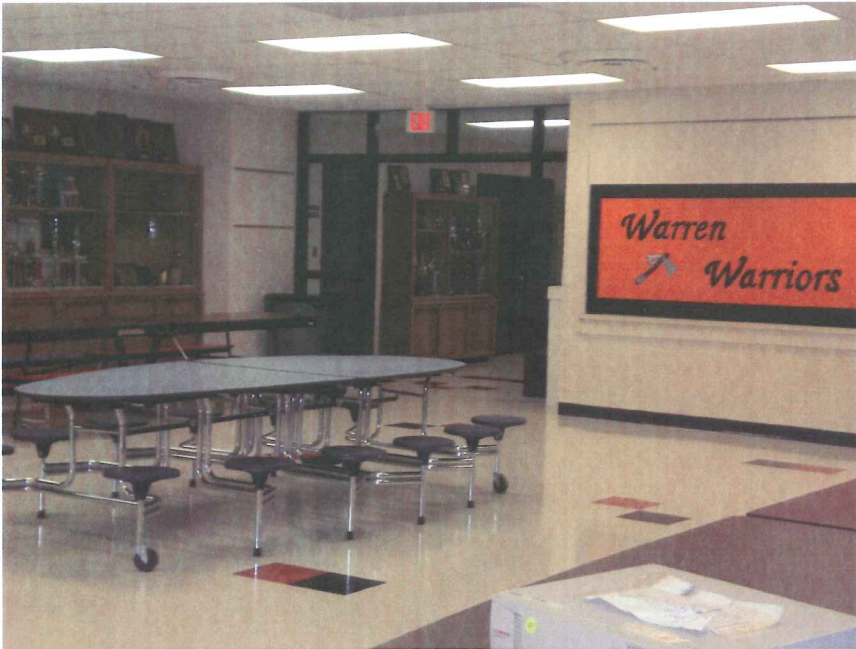
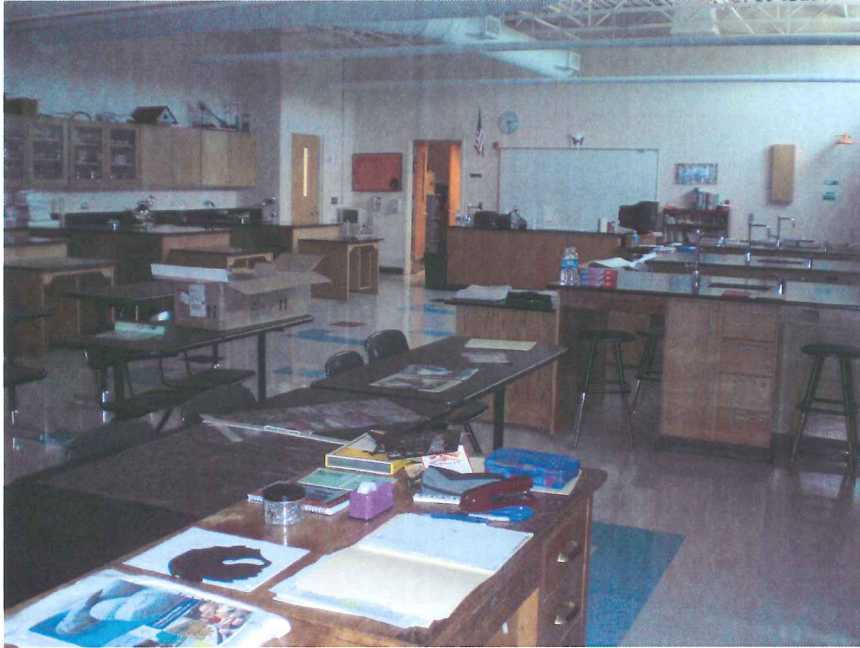


Hi Jody,

The Library was completely gutted. Two storage rooms flank the large desk area.



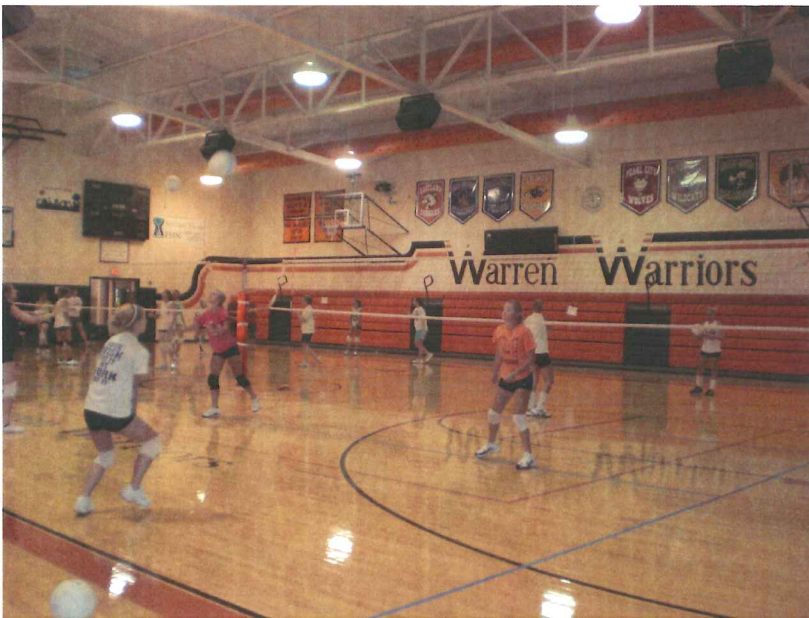
The library also has computers on three walls-WHS goes high-tech!



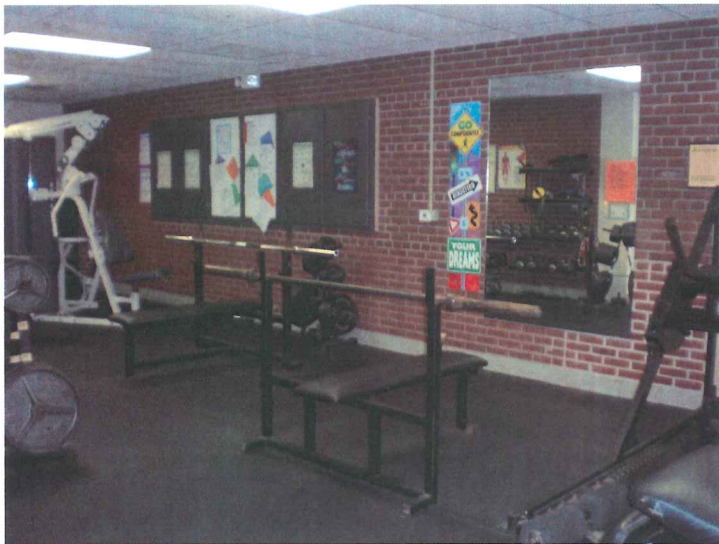
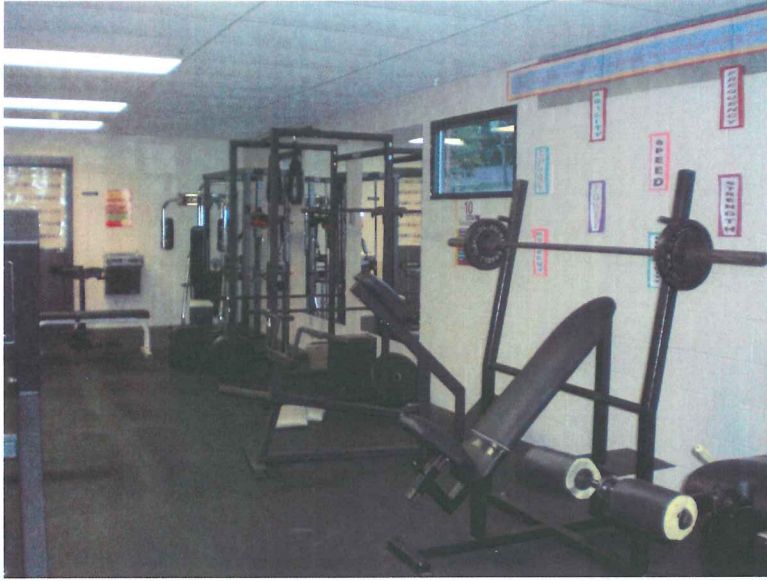
Chemistry classroom/lab. Mr. Ramaker and Mr. Smith would have enjoyed these super classrooms!

We received the Blue Ribbon award from the Illinois Association of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance. We were one of only eight schools in the state to achieve this award for outstanding Physical Education curriculum!!

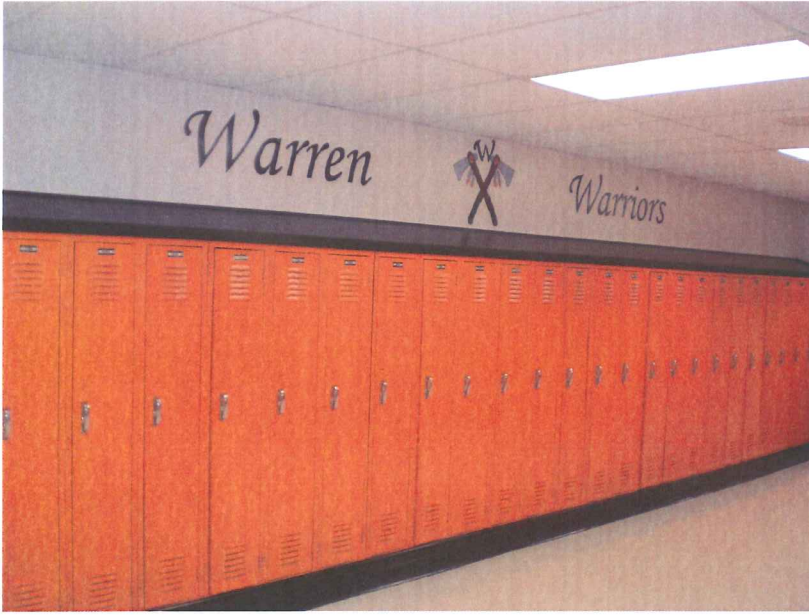
New Band room is right beside the girl's locker room. It has a huge supply closet as well as two instrument cubbies. Band brought home first place from our Conference Music Festival last spring!
